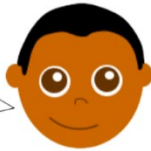

The population of Melbourne is 5 million (to the nearest million) and the population of Sydney is 5.1 million (to the nearest 100,000)

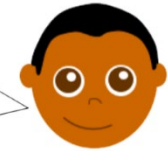

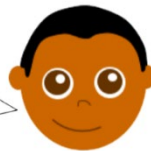


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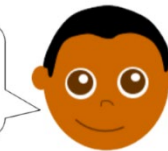
