Session 5: Represent Number 1 in Different Ways

Session Objectives:

Represent 1 using different representations

Represent amounts in their own ways, explaining what they mean

Key Skills Practice (Whole Class)

Focus: Watch Numberblocks Episode: Series 1 (One)

This episode introduces Number One.

- *What did Number One see in the story?*

Ask for children's suggestions using the sentence stem. **Number One saw one ...**

Extension: *What about Number One shows you it is Number One? (Eye / mouth / block). What doesn't? (Legs / arms)*

Guided Learning (Small Group Task)

Take the group to look at Numberland Number 1.

- *How have we shown number one here?*

Ask for children's suggestions, reiterating the use of **one ... because it is on its own**

Provide children with a large copy of the Number 1 Resource Sheet per pair.

- *How could you show number 1 in as many different ways as you can? Work together.*

Allow children three minutes to find items around the classroom that show number one and put them on their Number 1 sheet.

Discuss what has been found with the group.

Show them the My Number Book – Number 1 Resource Sheet. Ask them to write their name on the sheet. Provide them with a range of mark making materials and ask them to show number one on their sheet in different ways. They may choose to look at their practical representations to help them but they could also record other pictorial representations if they wished.

Extension: *If the circle is a group of things that show number one, what would go outside of the circle? Could you draw something that you think should go there?*
