CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Hall Gate Lane, Stalmine, from a point 19 metres northwest its junction with Mill Lane for a distance of 39 metres in a north westerly direction.
