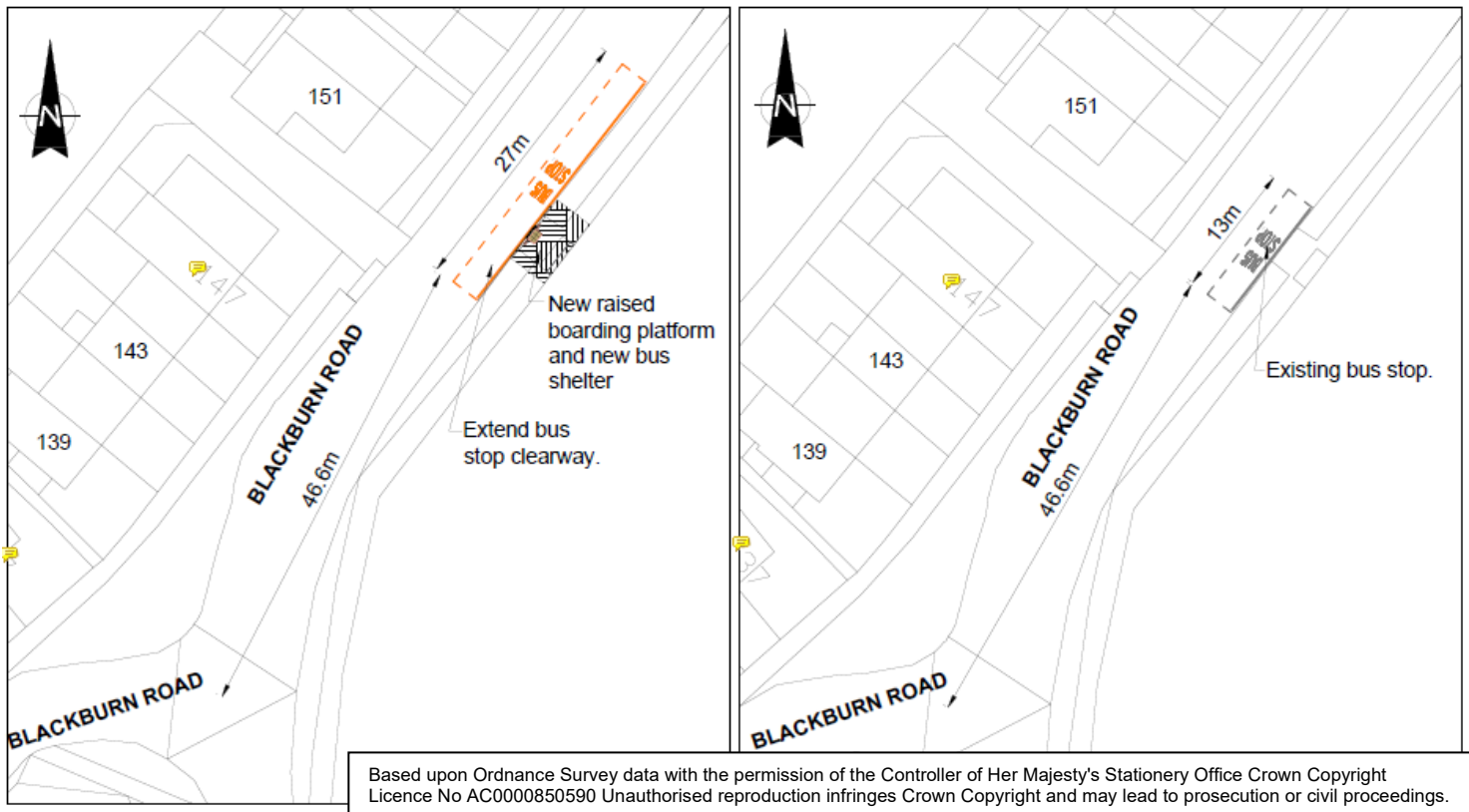


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BLACKBURN ROAD, HEAPEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF BUS STOP
CLEARWAY (NO3))

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stop clearway in Blackburn Road (C220), Heapey, the south east side, from a point 46.6 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Blackburn Road (U5803) for a distance of 13 metres in a north easterly direction
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Blackburn Road (C220), Heapey, the south east side, from a point 46.6 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Blackburn Road (U5803) for a distance of 27 metres in a north easterly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to extend the existing bus stop clearway by 14 metres to a 27 metre length, allowing buses to align correctly, safely and efficiently at the stop and allow for effective enforcement. The proposal also includes the construction of a raised boarding platform ensuring safe boarding and alighting of passengers.
