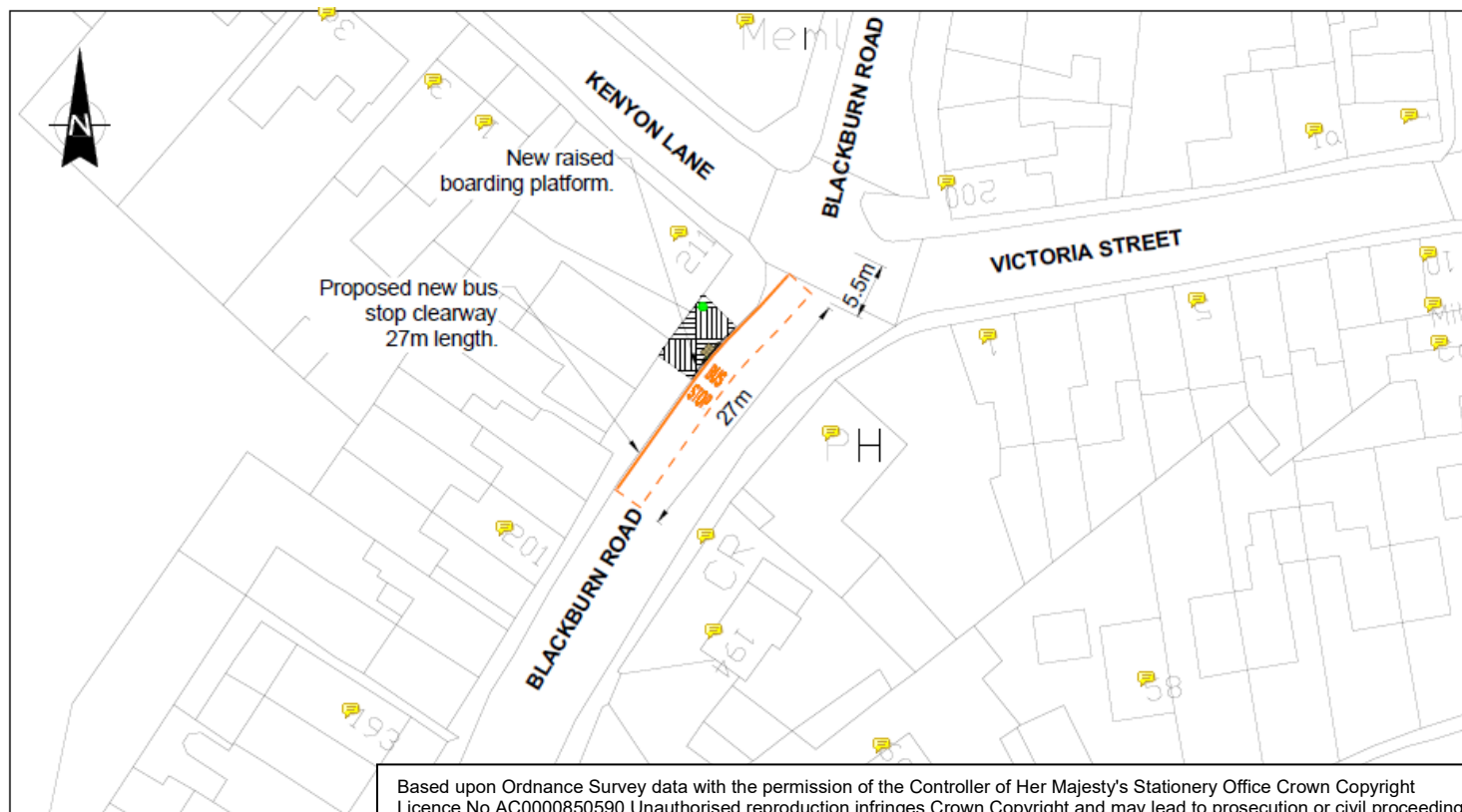


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

(BUS STOP CLEARWAY (NO1))



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Blackburn Road (C220), Heapey, the north west side, from a point 5.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Victoria Street for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop to a quality bus stop clearway. This is to allow the buses to pull in and out safely and allow for effective enforcement.

A raised boarding platform will also be installed to ensure safe boarding and alighting of passengers.
