

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COLNE ROAD AREA, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove bus stop clearways in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Briercliffe Road, Burnley, the southeast side, from a point 7 metres southwest of its junction with the centreline of Bar Street for a distance of 10.50 metres in a south westerly direction;
 - b) Colne Road, Burnley, the southeast side, from a point 3.97 metres northeast of its junction with the Centreline of Plantation Street a distance of 26.87 metres in a north easterly direction;
 - c) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 6.68 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Murray Street for a distance of 24.81 metres in a northerly direction;
 - d) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 10.5 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Brennand Street for a distance of 28.12 metres in a northerly direction;
 - e) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from its junction with the projected Centreline of Disraeli Street for a distance of 31.88 metres in a southerly direction;
 - f) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 21 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Disraeli Street for a distance of 11 metres in a northerly direction;
 - g) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 23.34 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Windermere Avenue for a distance of 26.23 metres in a northerly direction;
 - h) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 20 metres south of its junction with the Centreline of Casterton Avenue for a distance of 26 metres in a southerly direction;
 - i) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 15.38 metres northeast of its junction with the centreline of Rylands Street for a distance of 23 metres in a northerly direction;
 - j) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 36.11 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Newman Street for a distance of 24 metres in a southerly direction;
 - k) Colne Road, Burnley, the northwest side, from a point 31.67 metres southwest of its junction with the centreline of Hurlley Street for a distance of 20.5 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Briercliffe Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 8 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Bar Street for a distance of 9 metres in a southerly direction;
 - b) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 7 metres southwest of its junction with the Centreline of Plantation Street for a distance of 17 metres in a south westerly direction;
 - c) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 10.5 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Brennand Street for a distance of 13 metres in a northerly direction
 - d) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 18.5 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Murray Street for a distance of 13 metres in a northerly direction
 - e) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 19.30 metres south of its projected Centreline junction with Disraeli Street for a distance of 13 metres in a southerly direction
 - f) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 23.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Disraeli Street for a distance of 11 metres in a northerly direction
 - g) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 51.8m metres south of its junction with the Centreline of Casterton Avenue for a distance of 13 metres in a southerly direction
 - h) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 35.5 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Casterton/Windermere Avenue for a distance of 13 metres in a northerly direction
 - i) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 38.83 metres south of its junction with the Centreline of Newman Street for a distance of 21 metres in a southerly direction
 - j) Colne Road, Burnley, the east side, from a point 18.2 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Rylands Street for a distance of 21 metres in a northerly direction;
 - k) Colne Road, Burnley, the west side, from a point 30.4 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Hurlley Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

These proposals form part of the Levelling Up East Lancashire project. They aim to deliver improvements in local neighbourhoods through:

- Improving local streets with better connections through new or improved crossing facilities and pathways.
- Enhancing streets and public spaces with new planting and seating.
- Creating safer street environments that makes it easier for people to walk, cycle or wheel to local places.
- Improving facilities at local parks and providing new public green spaces.
- Improving road safety by discouraging pavement parking at junctions,
- Improving sight lines for people trying to cross the road and reducing traffic speeds.

The proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users, whilst also improving public realm in the area. The intention of the scheme is twofold, to:

- Foster a sense of pride in local communities by creating safer, greener neighbourhoods and revitalised public realm.
- Increase active travel uptake to improve health and wellbeing and reduce health inequalities.

These proposals include adjustment of length and positioning of existing Bus Stop Clearways to facilitate the proposed changes to the road layout.
