(DRUMACRE LANE EAST, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Drumacre Lane East, Longton from its junction with Land Lane, Longton for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1530 hours on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 1630 hours on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency carriageway repair works to be carried out.
