
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of New Lane, Burscough from where it merges with Marsh Moss Lane for a distance of 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> August until 0700 hours on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Marsh Moss Lane, Tarlscough Lane, Red Cat Lane, A59 Liverpool Road North, A59 Liverpool Road South, Higgins Lane, New Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow removal and replacement works of level crossing to be carried out.
