(SHORE ROAD, WARTON, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Shore Road, Warton for approximately 40 metres either side of the Hagg Lane rail bridge.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 13th August 2026 until 1700 hours on Thursday 13th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Shore Road – Crag Bank Lane – Crag Bank Road – A6 Main Road
– Haws Hill – Warton Road – Shore Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms pole replacement works to be carried out on behalf of BT Openreach.
