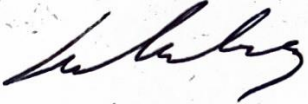
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stirling Road, Lancaster from its junction with Dunkeld Street to its junction with Elgin Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Stirling Road – Dumbarton Road – Aberdeen Road – Gregson Road –  
Stirling Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation in the footway and/or carriageway to replace existing electrical apparatus, and associated cables. Works involve removal of aged or damaged equipment, installation of new units, cable jointing, and testing.
