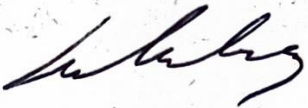
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Low Road, Halton from a point approximately 10 metres west of property no. 24 on Low Road, to its junction with Church Brow.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 24th August 2026 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 26th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Low Road – Green Lane – High Road – Church Brow and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to excavate joint bay in the footway with approximately 75 metres of track in private to install and joint cable for new connection to property be carried out.
